



How To – Use drama to bring your topic to life

Overview

Drama is a very useful tool to use in the classroom; it can help pupils understand series of events, characters, themes and issues. It can be used to bring information off a page and this helps certain pupils who are visual and/or kinaesthetic learners. Process

Through a series of exercises and techniques teachers will learn quick and easy ways of bringing a topic to life; some of these exercises can be done with limited space – we all know time in the hall is hard to come by. These little hints and tips are sure to make your lessons more interactive and fun for not only the pupils but the teacher as well.

- Warm Up exercises (you can adapt for any topic)
- Frozen statues
- Thought tracking
- Frozen tableaux
- Mime
- Improvisation techniques
- Exercises working individually, in pairs, groups
- Exercises you can do in 5minutes within your classroom
