Since 2003, Tron Participation has explored, created and collaborated with young people of all ages through a range of creative arts workshops, projects and performance opportunities to discover and develop practical artistic skills in tandem with developing a valuable set of life skills.

Tron Ambassadors

Aim: To provide young people with opportunities to experience a range of the career opportunities available within a fully operational theatre.

Why: To enable deeper connections with the Tron Theatre and the work we do both in-house and in the community, gaining a better understanding of the wider theatre and creative arts industries.

How: Ambassadors will take part in regular workshops with Tron staff, external visitors and leading professionals to identify and develop transferable skills such as self-confidence, awareness, ideas and expression, teamwork, time management, organisational skills, interview skills, research skills, problem solving, leading and delegating and more – all of which can be applied to any career path they choose to follow when leaving school.

Previous Tron Ambassadors have worked with Tron production, marketing and front of house departments, theatre critics, set and costume designers and professional actors and directors to gain first-hand experience of the different roles within a theatre setting, and said it has been an enjoyable and educational experience they would recommend to others.

New for 2018

This year, Tron Ambassadors will also be eligible to gain an Arts Award qualification from their full participation in the programme. This is a nationally recognised certificate that will enhance the experience and complement future educational / career applications.
