GRANT ANDERSON – LIGHTING DESIGNER

Grant is a lighting designer for the entertainment industry whose work covers the worlds of theatre, music, events, fashion and architecture.

Grant trained at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland receiving the Dean of Drama Award for Best Individual Work.

Theatre projects include work for National Theatre of Scotland, Edinburgh International Festival, Dundee Rep Theatre, Royal Lyceum Theatre Edinburgh, Citizens Theatre, Tron Theatre, Noisemaker, Birds of Paradise, Sleeping Warrior and Sell A Door Worldwide.

Grant is the lighting designer for some of Scotland's major events including the Enchanted Forest, GlasGLOW, Elfingrove and Edinburgh's Hogmanay.

As well as the UK he designs internationally for the team at Woodroffe Bassett Design, WBD.

Eva has been working as a choreographer in the UK for the past twenty years. In her early years she performed with the Black Eyed Peas, Justin Timberlake and Kylie. She was a dancer at Disneyland Paris, performing daily in the parades. She was also an ensemble dancer for Costa Cruise lines.

Eva has now dedicated her career to teaching. She works in high schools in Glasgow teaching National 5, Higher and HNC level dance. She loves inspiring young children and enabling them to discover their love for the arts.

Eva works for a variety of performing arts schools and is the resident choreographer for Inter Performing Arts in Glasgow. Choreography credits include: *Legally Blonde*, *Hairspray*, *Little Shop of Horrors*, *We Will Rock You*, *The Addams Family*, *School of Rock* and *All Shook Up*.

He completed his MA(hons) in Theatre Studies at Glasgow University, before moving to London to study at Mountview and graduating with a Masters degree in Acting. He is very excited to be back in Glasgow performing as part of the Tron panto this year.

JOHNNY MCKNIGHT – WRITER/DIRECTOR/STINKERBELL

Johnny McKnight is an award-winning writer, director, educator, dramaturg and performer. His theatre work includes the recent tour of *101 Dalmatians* (Runaway Entertainment) and *No Love Songs* (Dundee Rep) which played Goodspeed Terris Theatre, Connecticut. He has been described as the 'vanguard of post-modernist panto', with 31 productions and last year's Tron Theatre panto *Aganeza Scrooge* winning Best Panto (under 500 seats) and *Aladdin* (Macrobert) winning Achievement In Inclusive Practice at the UK Panto Awards. His recent directing credits include: *Radiant Vermin* (Tron Theatre); *Thrown* (National Theatre of Scotland/Edinburgh International Festival); *Aladdin* (Macrobert) and *The Wonderful Wizard Of Oz* (Tron Theatre). Johnny also writes for screen, his 20th Anniversary Special of *River City* won the 2024 Royal Television Award (Scotland) for Best Drama.

KENNY MILLER – DESIGNER

Kenny Miller is a freelance designer and director who was for many years Head of Design/Associate Director at the Citizens Theatre, Glasgow. He has worked in theatre and opera both nationally and internationally, designing and directing for many companies.

He has won three Critics' Awards for Theatre in Scotland: *Scrooge* (Best Production); *Smoking With Lulu* (Best Technical) and *A Little Bit of Ruff* (Best Ensemble). He has also won the Manchester Evening News Award for *10 Rillington Place* (Best Designed Production).

STAR PENDERS – PETER PANTO

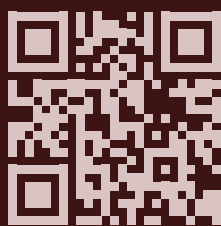
